Event EMS and First Aid Services Agreement

This Agreement and General Release made this 23rd day of July, 2026 between the Hatboro-Horsham School District (Event Holder) and Horsham Fire Company #1 (HFC), a Pennsylvania Department of Health Certified Emergency Service Provider.

Whereas, the Event Holder desires a first aid station at the location of a mass gathering of people for an event.

Whereas, the Event Holder has secured all applicable permits and permissions from Federal, State, Local Governments and property owners as indicated by Federal, State and Local laws.

Whereas, the Event Holder understands that HFC shall remain a sub-contractor of the Event Holder. Therefore, the Event Holder releases HFC from any liability or responsibility of the actual event.

Whereas, HFC agrees to provide first aid coverage as per the limitations and guidelines of Commonwealth Law under the provision of the Pennsylvania Department of Health Guidelines in which they are bound under the constraints of HFC's Pennsylvania Department of Health Licensure.

Now, Therefore, for and in consideration of mutual covenants and promises herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, do hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1) HFC will provide at least one fully licensed unit to provide the level of on-scene first aid as per the request of the Event Holder.
- 2) HFC retains the right to bill all patients' medical insurance for treatment and/or transport as per Federal and Commonwealth insurance regulations.
- 3) Event Holder agrees to pay for these services as per Schedule "A" attached to this agreement.
- 4) Event Holder agrees to allow Horsham to distribute information on volunteer recruitment and/or fund raising efforts.
- 5) Event Holder understands, as per HFC's state licensure as an emergency medical provider, HFC's primary responsibility is to respond to actual emergencies within the primary coverage area, in this case, Horsham Township. HFC's secondary responsibility is to respond to actual emergencies in surrounding communities who call for mutual aid support. HFC's third priority is an event where emergencies *could* occur. Therefore, HFC may have to call on emergency units at the event to answer emergency calls. If this should happen, the Event Holder is to utilize the 9-1-1 system in the event of an emergency. The Event Holder will not be billed for time units are not on location.
