Background & Rationale



- A key component of MTSS is the development of intervention plans and the implementation of data-driven instructional decisions.
- Act 47 of 2025 requires literacy/reading intervention plans for students by the year 2027.

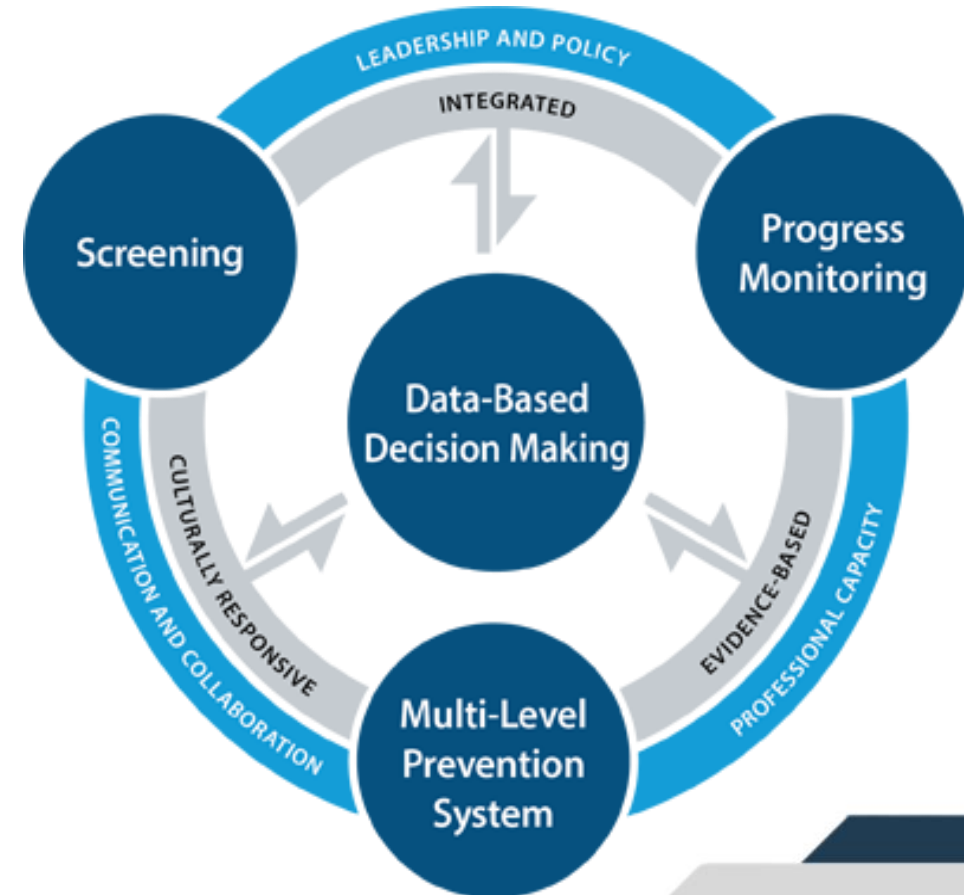

Timeline

September-December 2025

Began evaluating data systems within MTSS with the District MTSS Leadership Team.

March 2026

MTSS Leadership Team determined need for intervention management tool through goal setting and data planning.

August 2026

Recommendation to pilot Branching Minds & Infinite Campus MTSS Tool in 6 buildings within the district during the 26-27 SY.

January 2026

Completed Tools Inventory to evaluate degree to which we are using our current tools to support MTSS.

April-June 2026

CARE-I report recommendation of automating processes supported review of multiple MTSS solution tools. Team completed rubric to evaluate programs abilities to meet CB need.

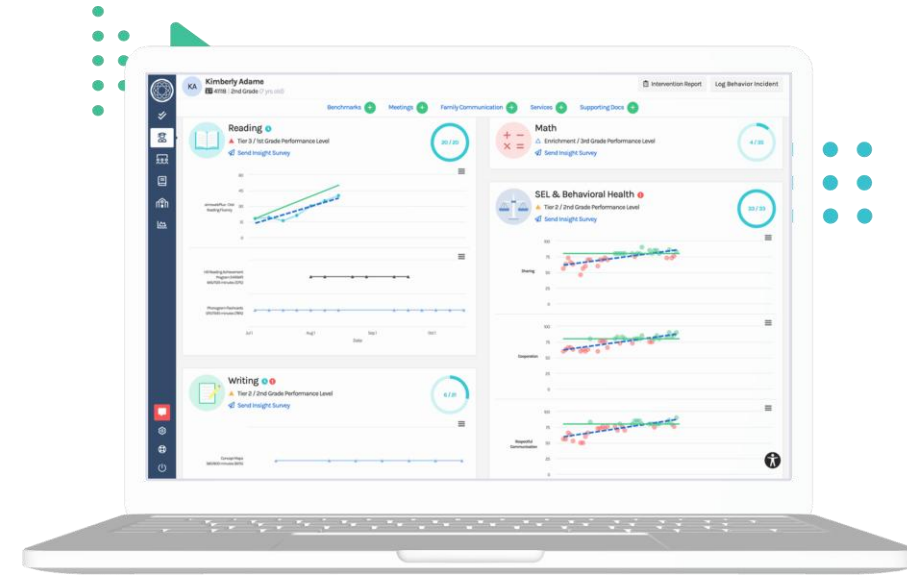
Infinite Campus

Branching Minds



Brings together academic, behavior, and attendance data with intervention planning in one space.

- Automatic and manual data integrations.
- Creation & historical maintenance of intervention plans.
- Customizable to fit district needs.
- Workflow solution to support teachers and administrators.



Branching Minds Cont.

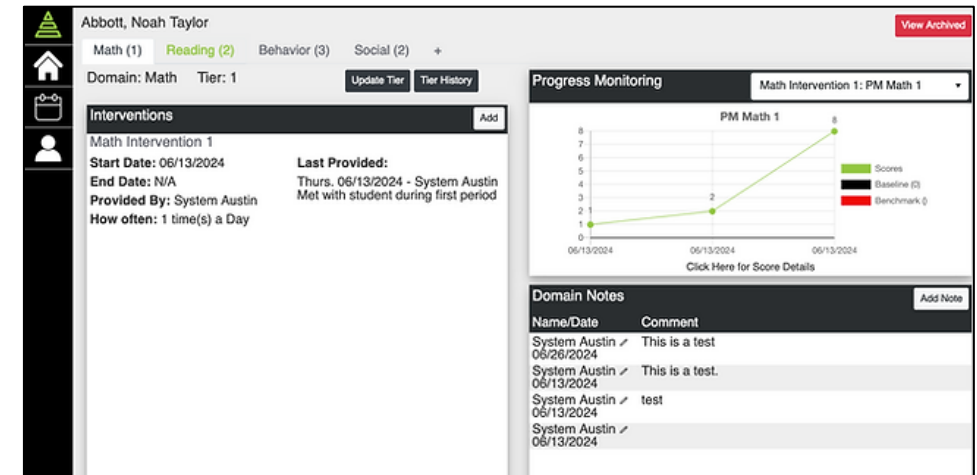
- Access to create intervention plans with all necessary components.
- Reduces manual entry of data into spreadsheets.
- Visualization of progress monitoring scores to support data-based decision making.
- Maintains data over time to identify trends and areas of need.
- Provides automatic MTSS data analysis.
- Ability to evaluate holistic MTSS data as a district.

Infinite Campus



A whole-student framework built into the Infinite Campus student information system to track screening, monitor progress, and manage academic, behavior, and attendance interventions.

- Full integration with Infinite Campus.
- Customizable settings and options.
- MTSS dashboard used to initiate an MTSS entry for a student.
- Add customizable domains and interventions.
- Staff dashboard to allow staff to easily view students to access MTSS details, domains, interventions, and monitor progress.
- Intervention dashboard to filter and view all interventions by student.
- Report options are available and being added.



Infinite Campus Cont.



- Explored previously and improvements have been made.
- Expansion of current Student Information System (SIS).
- Access to create intervention plans with necessary components.
- Reduces manual entry of data into spreadsheets.
- Visualization of progress monitoring scores to support data-based decision making.
- Maintains data over time to identify trends and areas of need.
