I am writing this second letter on behalf of the Church of Pentecost U.S.A. Inc., located at 1079 S. Cameron Street, Harrisburg, PA 17104, regarding the updated real property tax amount listed as owed in the sum of \$24,822.53 for the property identified as Property ID: 01 032 023 00 0000.

The Church of Pentecost U.S.A. Inc. is a non-profit religious organization, and the property referenced above is used solely for church purposes. Since the purchase of this building in 2017, the church has been recognized as tax-exempt, and the property has not been used as a school or for any commercial purpose.

Upon receiving the Notice of Change in Assessment, we promptly followed the appropriate procedures by appearing before the Dauphin County Board of Assessment Appeals to request a tax exemption for the property. After reviewing our case, the Board granted the tax-exempt.

Considering the Board's decision, we respectfully request that the real property tax amount of \$24,822.53 be reviewed and adjusted accordingly, since the Church qualifies as a tax-exempt institution under the applicable regulations.

Please let us know if verification from the Dauphin County Board of Assessment Appeals is required to resolve this matter.

Thank you for your time and consideration of this request. We look forward to your assistance in ensuring that the property records reflect the approved tax-exempt status.
